

The summer school is addressed to **Ph.D. students and young scholars** from different economic fields (i.e., economics, finance, innovation, entrepreneurship, management) interested in:

- receiving insights to **better understand the complexities of the green transition** in the European environment.
- understanding how to **write and publish high-quality research** related to the sustainability industry.
- Strengthening both **personal and professional connections**.



Structure of the Summer School

- Seminars led by renowned academics and experts from the sustainability and investment sectors.
- Roundtables on highly relevant topics from both an academic and policy lens.
- Labs addressing research opportunities and challenges in specific academic fields.
- Networking events as opportunities to come together, deepen connections and share valuable insights.



Registration

The summer school targets **early-career researchers** (e.g., PhD students, post-docs, or faculty with a recent PhD).

To ensure the quality of the summer school and an intimate and stimulating environment, we will welcome about **15 participants**.

To participate, it is necessary to submit an application by April 30th, 2024, sending a 350-word abstract to the address <u>laura.toschi@unibo.it</u>, indicating whether it is a preliminary research idea or a research at an advanced stage of development. Both empirical and theoretical works are welcome.
