Registration

The summer school targets **early-career researchers** (e.g., PhD students, post-docs, or faculty with a recent PhD).

To ensure the quality of the summer school and an intimate and stimulating environment, we will welcome about **15 participants**.

To participate, it is necessary to submit an application by **April 30th, 2024**, sending a **350-word abstract** to the address laura.toschi@unibo.it, indicating whether it is a preliminary research idea or a research at an advanced stage of development. Both empirical and theoretical works are welcome.

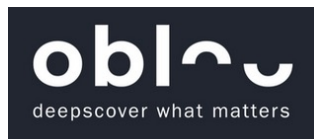
